## **CHAPTER T-3**

## TIME UNIFORMITY ACT

1. There shall be one uniform time in use throughout Prince Atlantic Standard Edward Island which shall be Atlantic Standard Time except as hereings hereinaster provided. 1956,c.42,s.1.

2. Unless altered by Order-in-Council as hereafter provided, the Official time official in the Official time of th official time shall be the Standard Time as established by clause 20 (m) 20 in 16 R.S.P.E.I. (m) of the Interpretation Act, R.S.P.E.I. 1974, Cap. I-6. R.S.P.E.I. 1951,c.161,s.2.

3. The Lieutenant Governor in Council may by Order-in-Council Daylight Saving Institute (so called) being institute the observance of Daylight Saving Time (so called) being One have the observance of Daylight Saving Time (so called) being one hour in advance of standard time, for such period of time during each year as may be deemed advisable; and when so instituted, such time of the period so specified. time shall be deemed the official time during the period so specified. R.S.P.E.I. 1951,c.161,s.3.

4. If the governing authority of any city, town or village declares any time and governing authority of any city, town or village declares any of the state of th time effective within its corporate limits other than the time in force under this Act, the Lieutenant Governor in Council may withhold from from the corporation any per capita grants voted by the Legislature to such city, town or village. 1956,c.42,s.2.
