CHAPTER 42

An Act To Amend The Time Uniformity Act

(Assented to March 29, 1956)

BE IT ENACTED by the Lieutenant-Governor and Legislative Assembly of the Province of Prince Edward Island as follows:

1. Section 1 of The Time Uniformity Act, R.S. P.E.I. Prohibition of 1951, Chapter 161, is repealed and the following sub- use of time other than stituted therefor:

Standard

- There shall be one uniform time in use throughout Prince Edward Island which shall be Atlantic Standard Time except as hereinafter provided."
- 2. The said Act is further amended by adding thereto power of the following as section 4:

"4. If the governing authority of any city, town or withhold Village declares any time effective within its corporate limits other than the time in force under this Act, the Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council may withold from such corporation any per capita grants voted by the Legislature to such city, town or village."
